

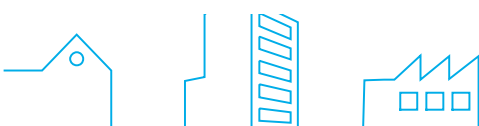
## Daikin unveils new full-electric and plug-in hybrid transport refrigeration lineup at SOLUTRANS in Lyon

- **Daikin Telematics** is a new connectivity platform that will be included as standard in Exigo and benefits from Daikin's extensive service network in the EMEA region, including a complete range of service offerings. Introduced for the first time, a live demo allows visitors to Solutrans to explore all features and applications.



- **Daikin's full lineup of electric and conventional van and truck refrigeration units** can be explored at Solutrans including the Zanotti portfolio with Invisible and Zero van units both available as battery-electric and direct-drive, SFZ light truck drive-drive and Uno engine-powered truck units.
- The **Exigo roadshow trailer** is fully operational for food and pharma transports and will be exhibited in the outdoor area near the Daikin stand.

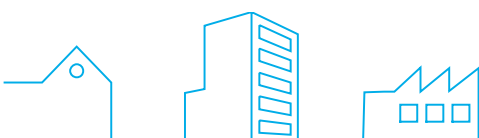
